

to your testimony you thought it would help to put in that he was in the Department of Justice or that Mr. Chambers had told you so? A It would have no significance to me.

Q Of course, you have found out since that Mr. Hiss didn't enter the Department of Justice until I think the 1st of August 1935? The F.B.I., of course, have told you that, or Mr. Chambers? A No, nobody has told me that.

Q No? Now, Mrs. Chambers, you said a moment ago after I had asked you a question that you thought it couldn't be the Department of Justice because Mr. Hiss was then conducting an inquiry or was counsel for the Nye Committee?

A Yes.

Q Now, haven't you added that because of the exhibit for identification the picture in the Baltimore Sun in September 1934, that I showed you? A No, I didn't look at that very carefully.

Q Now, who was present when Mr. Hiss was introduced to you? A My baby and Mr. Chambers.

Q Your child, Mr. Chambers and yourself? A That is correct.

Q Is that right? A That is right.

Q Now, you had never met Mr. Hiss before that time?

A No.

Q When he was introduced to you he was introduced as Mr. Alger Hiss? A Right.
