

Beginning at Teheran, then at Yalta and Potsdam, secret agreements were made breaching the pledges of the Atlantic Charter signed by Russia, January 1, 1942.

As a result, Presidents Roosevelt and Truman, confronted by a war-ravaged Soviet Union, unable without vast American aid to stand up to Germany, surrounded and advised by pro-Soviet advisers such as Alger Hiss and others already named in the spy hearings and more still to be named, gave away half the world and all the principles for which we fought, to the Red Dictatorship. Today we face this Red Frankenstein in Berlin, Vienna, Greece, the Near East, in Korea, Japan, China, Malaya, Burma, Indo China and Indonesia built up by American treachery and American timidity.

American Foreign Policy has been in the hands of Presidents Roosevelt and Truman. Congress granted the funds they asked. Theirs is the responsibility; Pres. Truman, and the Democrats who advised him and who sat with him and with Roosevelt at the conferences where the world was sold down the river, must accept full responsibility.

Chairman of Committee or other spokesman should issue statements from headquarters when no advisable for Mr. Dewey to do so. Statements along following or similar lines:

(1) To make plain Democratic responsibility for infiltration of Communists in Government:

- (a) As spies in State, Army, Navy, Air, Atom, USIS, Voice of America, Commerce, UN delegates and employees.
- (b) Communist control of U.S. Policy in State, Commerce, Treasury, Bureau of Budget, Congressional committee staffs, Library of Congress legislative service, Indian service, U.N. representation, Pacific Island Trusteeships, occupied areas, etc.

(2) To demand action as situations arise:

- (a) To take thunder away from Truman when he finally acts.
- (b) To put him on spot when he does not.
- (c) To oppose all attempts at delay and secrecy--such as proposed Commission of Roberts, Eisenhower, etc., no matter how distinguished, as it would throw the mantle of secrecy over entire matter like Pearl Harbor report.

(3) Committee to report on any questions put to it. Facts and conclusions.

(4) Committee to call attention to all issues concerning domestic or foreign communism. Facts and recommendations.

(5) Call for removal from critical State Dept. and occupation Government positions of people of questionable loyalty, with dossier on each.

(6) Stress that all real left-wingers are anti-Stalinist. All left-wingers not anti-Stalinist are either lone wolves expecting to change our government singlehanded or crypto-Communists.
